Introduction

Everyone's privacy is important to our Website. Ongoing intentions are to always make the online experience as safe and secure as possible.

This notice applies to any online service, or communication from the domain Warningcamp.org.uk, or heavens-end.co.uk. This extends to our email mailing list and 'Residents Area' .

Who we are?

Warningcamp.org.uk are the organisation who have setup and maintain a website for Warningcamp Village. You may communicate with us at contact@warningcamp.org.uk

What information do we collect?

We keep your collected data to a minimum. If you sign up for our mailing list, we simply hold your email address in a database. Equally if you sign up the 'Resident's Area' Platform we only hold minimal information including your chosen Username, Email Address and Internet Protocol Address.

This information is processed by computer script, or occasionally manually depending on which way you offer your details.

How do we use personal information?

We use the data very seldom. Your email address is simply used for communication to you, and as a login credential to our website. The data previously mentioned is used to identify your user account and enables you to view / post information on the platform.

What legal basis do we have for processing your personal data?

Our data gathering is conducted in such a way only your data offered up and consented against is used.

When do we share personal data?

We would never pass your data on to any other person or organisation. On the 'Resident's Area' your username will be available for registered users to see.

In regards to the mailing list, we endeavour to remove email addresses from all forwarded mail however the distribution is an automatic process and some public emails may be shared through the system.

Where do we store and process personal data?

Your data is stored across our own in-house servers, and emails are processed to our system by UK company 123-REG.

How do we secure personal data?

Data is always secured by virtual technologies such as passwords and encryption. Physical items containing your data are always secured in locked premises and destroyed as soon as no longer required.

How long do we keep your personal data for?

Data is only kept for as long as you wish to be part of our systems. As soon as possible, after PID (Personally identifiable data) removal request, data is removed and destroyed by methods of total destruction.

Your rights in relation to personal data

- You may request to see what data we hold on you at any time
- Corrections or requests for removal of your data will be processed in a timely fashion
- You may revoke your consent at any time
