Introduction

Everyone's privacy is important to our Website. Ongoing intentions are to always make the online experience as safe and secure as possible.

Who we are?

What information do we collect?

We keep your collected data to a minimum. There is no need to provide any personal details to use our public website.

If you sign up for our mailing, we may collect your email address, along with names and street address if you provide this.

This information is processed by computer script, or occasionally manually depending on which way you offer your details.

How do we use personal information?

We seldom use any data. Your email address if provided, is simply used for communication to you.

What legal basis do we have for processing your personal data?

Our data gathering is conducted in such a way only your data offered up and consented against is used.

When do we share personal data?

The only site user data collected is by our partner's for operational reasons as per the cookie policy. No other data is collected.

In regards to the mailing list and email communication, we endeavour to remove any unnecessary data and it is only used for the purpose of our Village communications. We do not sell or share data with a 3rd party other than those listed in this privacy policy to facilitate day to day operations.

Where do we store and process personal data?

Any data collected by Warningcamp.org.uk held by our trusted and hosting partner, who is ISO27001 compliant. Our mailing list is also held by a communications partner who incorporate the EU's standard contractual clauses in our Data Processing Addendum.

How do we secure personal data?

Data is always secured by virtual technologies such as passwords and encryption. Physical items containing your data are always secured in locked premises and destroyed as soon as no longer required.

How long do we keep your personal data for?

Data is only kept for as long as you wish to be part of our systems. As soon as possible, after PID (Personally identifiable data) removal request, data is removed and destroyed by methods of total destruction.
